What is Canvas LMS?

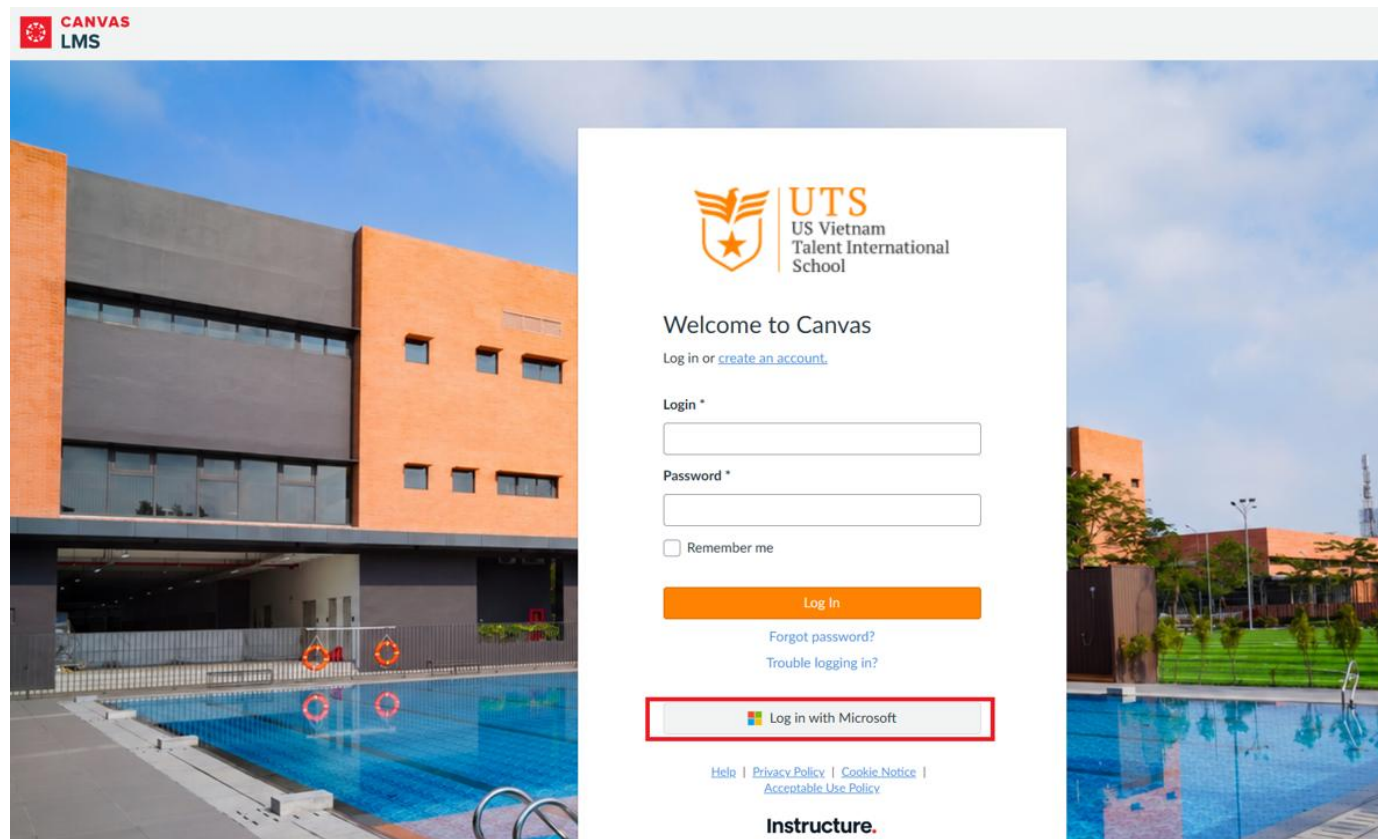
Canvas LMS is an online learning platform used by the School to organize and centralize Students' learning content in one unified environment.

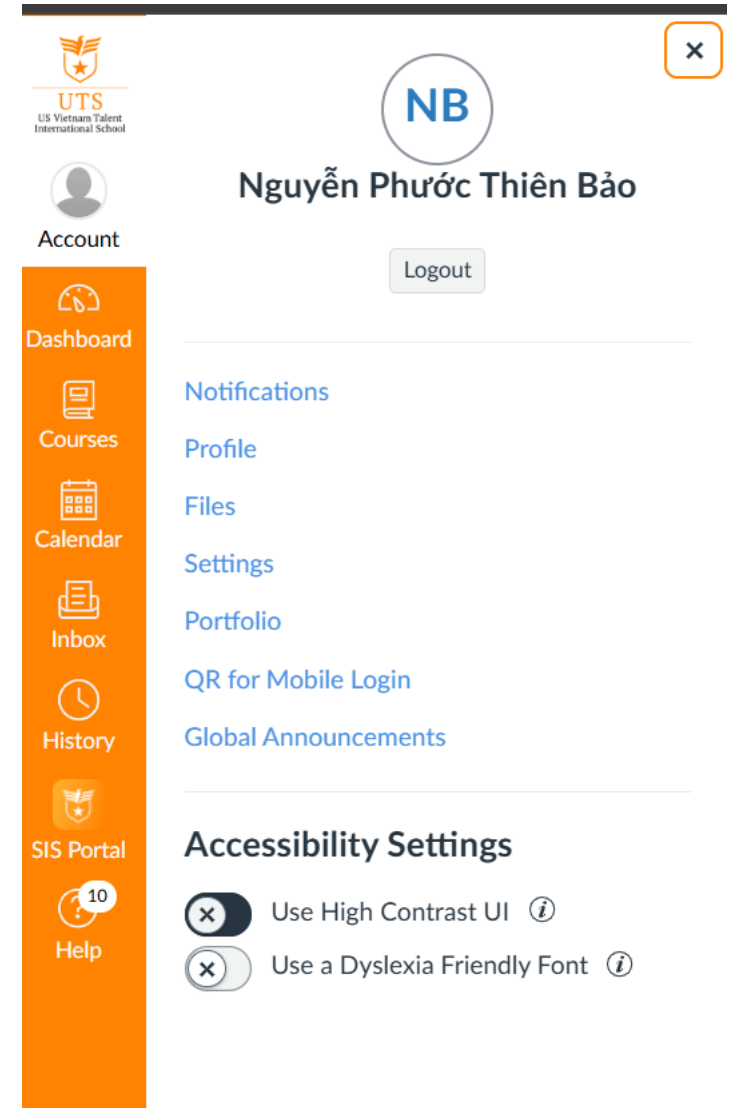
- 5 Enter "**UTS – Students**" in the search bar and select the corresponding option.



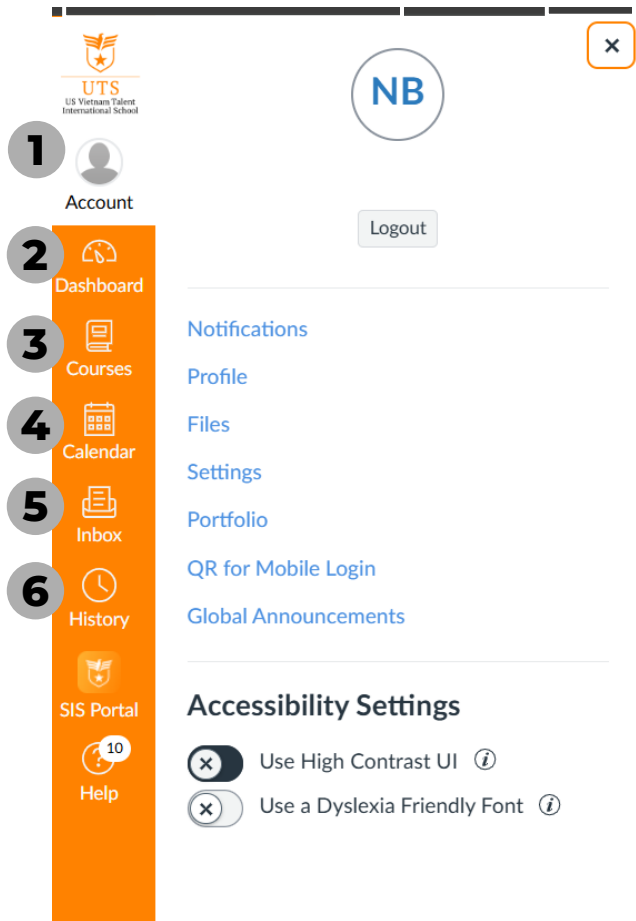

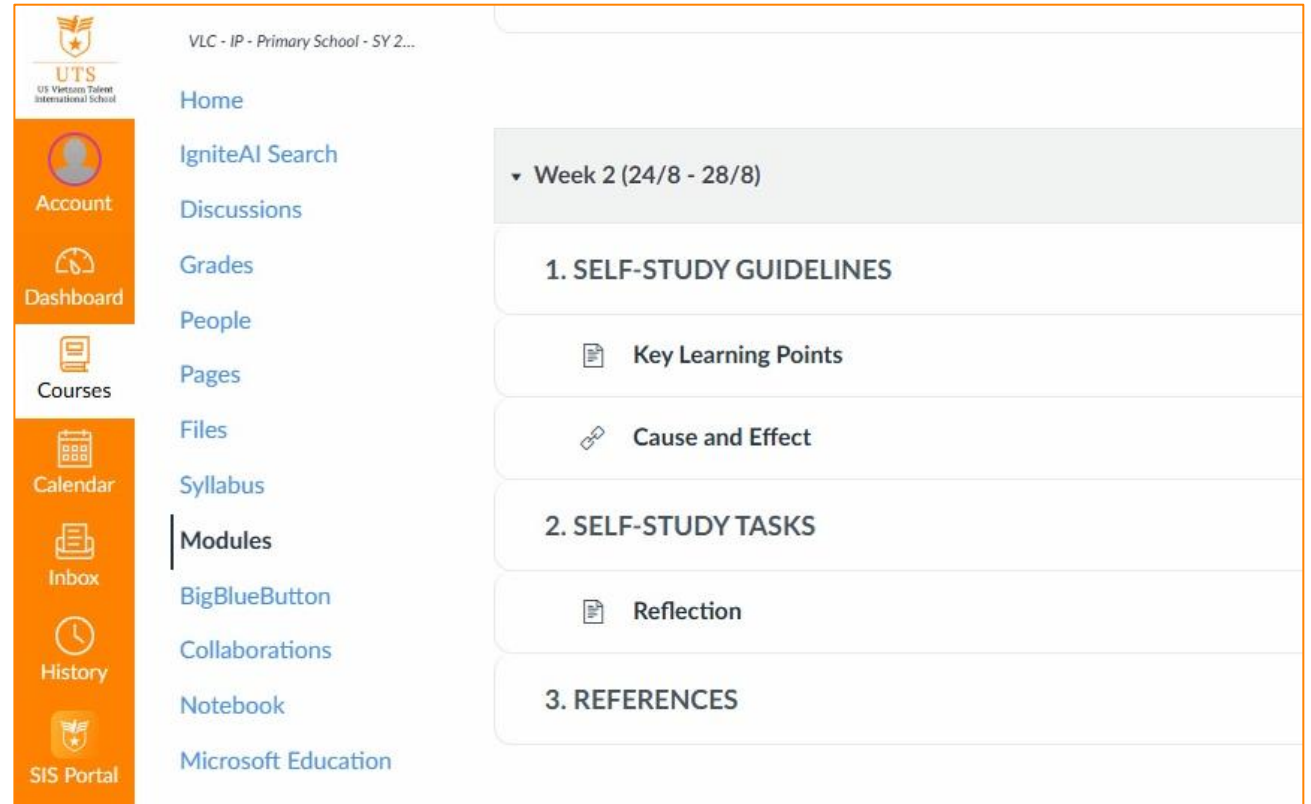

- 2 Dashboard:** view the student's courses, announcements and schedule.
- 3 Courses:** view the list of courses the student is enrolled in.
- 4 Calendar:** view learning activities and assignment due dates.
- 5 Inbox:** All messages and announcements that teachers send to the whole class or to individual students
- 6 History:** View recently visited pages

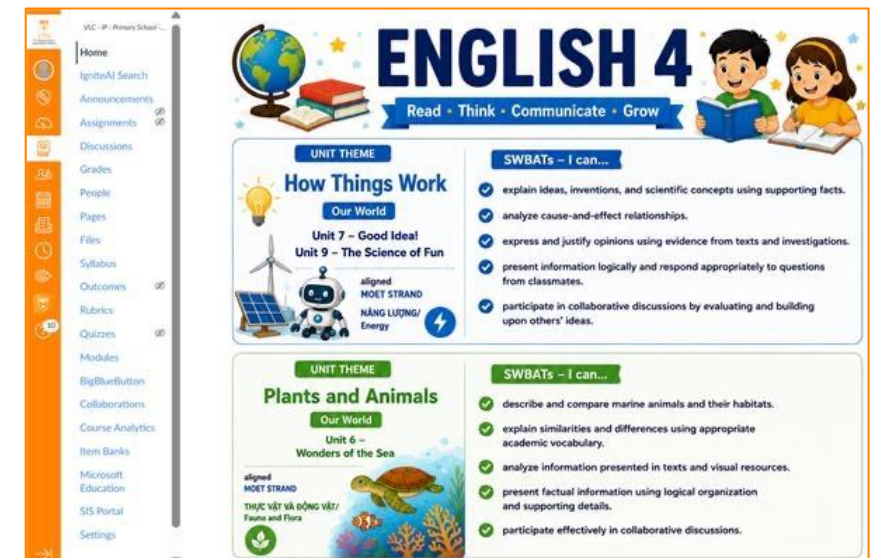
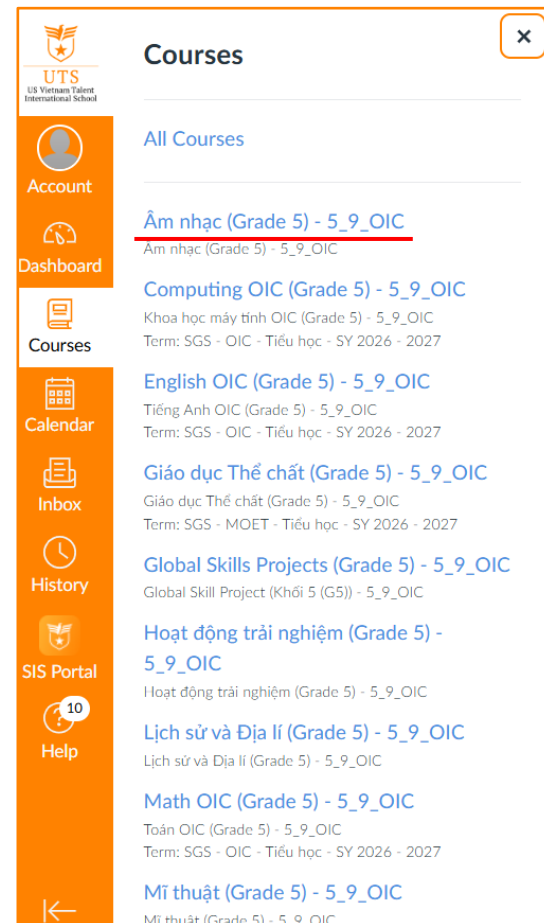
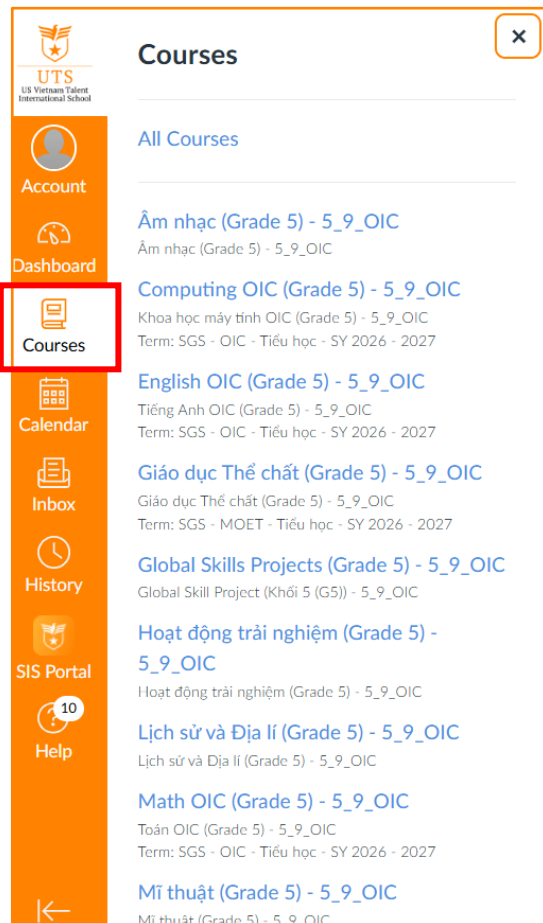

2 Select the subject for which the Student would like to view the learning materials.

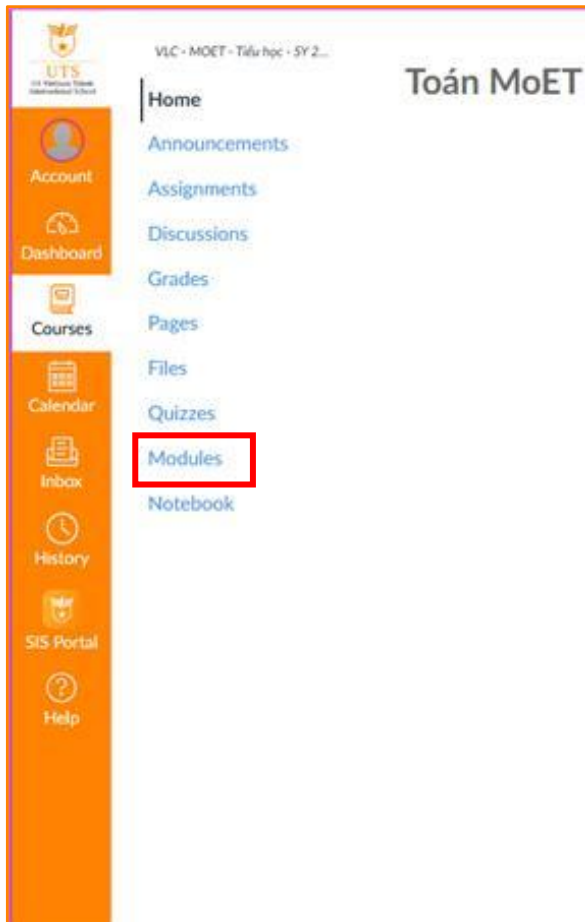
3 The screen will display all information about the selected subject.



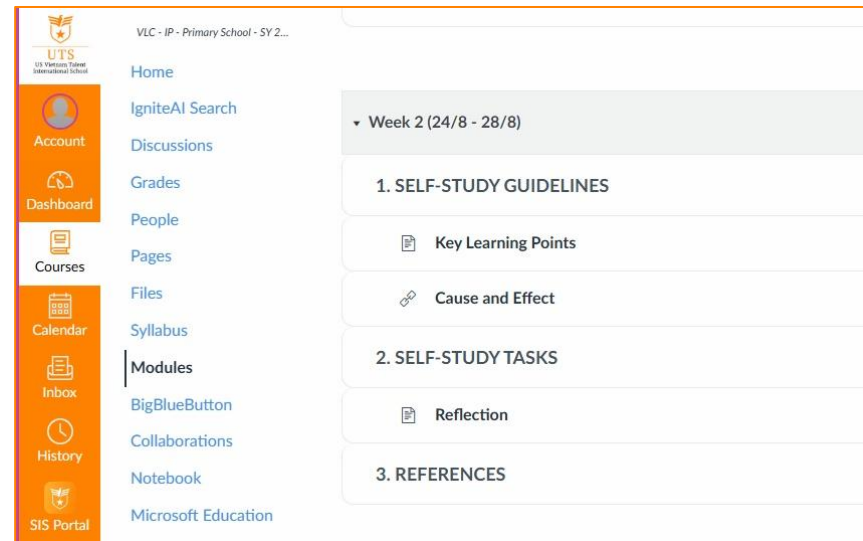

1. Self-Study Guidelines

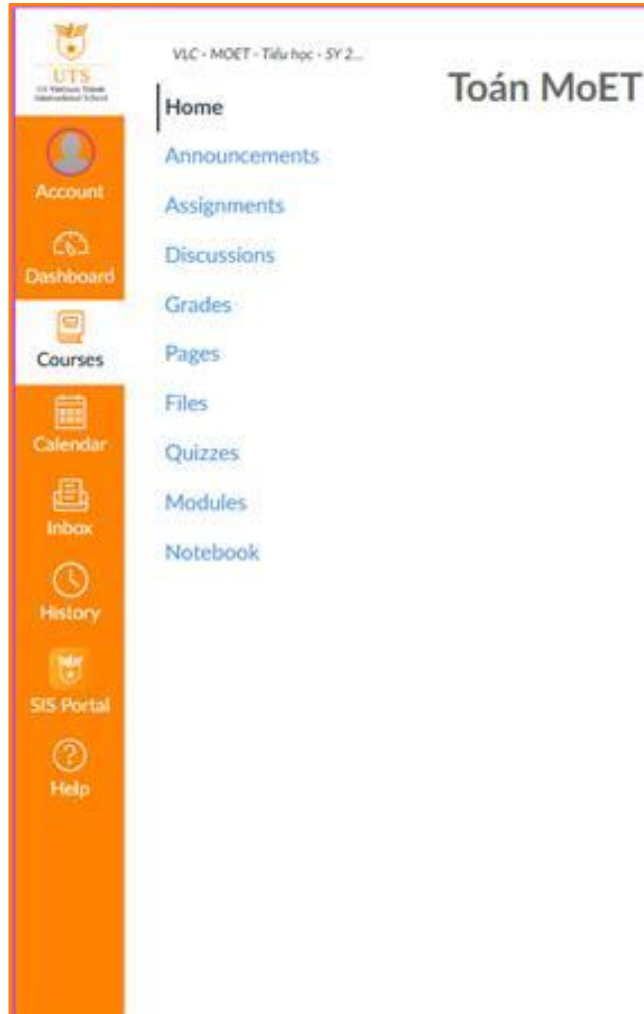
Provides key content and guidance to help Students prepare for or review lessons independently.

2. Self-Study Tasks

Includes activities and exercises suited to each grade level and subject, helping students check their understanding and identify areas for further review.

3. Reference (if any)

Provides additional materials for Students to explore.



The **Courses** toolbar includes the following features:

Home: Provides an overview of the subject.

Announcements: Updates from Teachers.

Assignments: View and complete assigned tasks.

Discussions: Discuss and exchange ideas about learning content.

Grades: Track grades and learning progress.

Pages: Access learning content and materials shared by Teachers.

Files: Access and manage subject learning materials.

Quizzes: Complete online quizzes and assessments.

Modules: Access weekly learning content.

Notebook: Take and save learning notes.
